Are you kidding me?

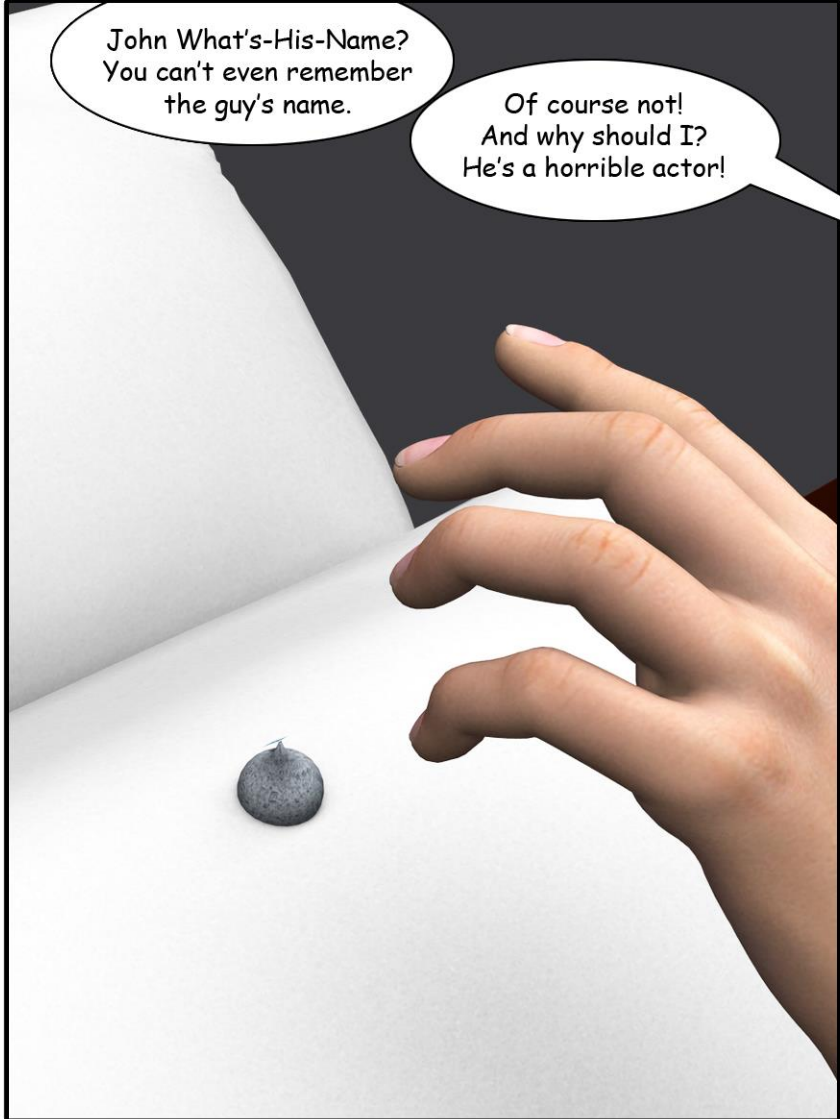
The story was so contrived, I couldn't help laughing every five minutes!

completely wrong!

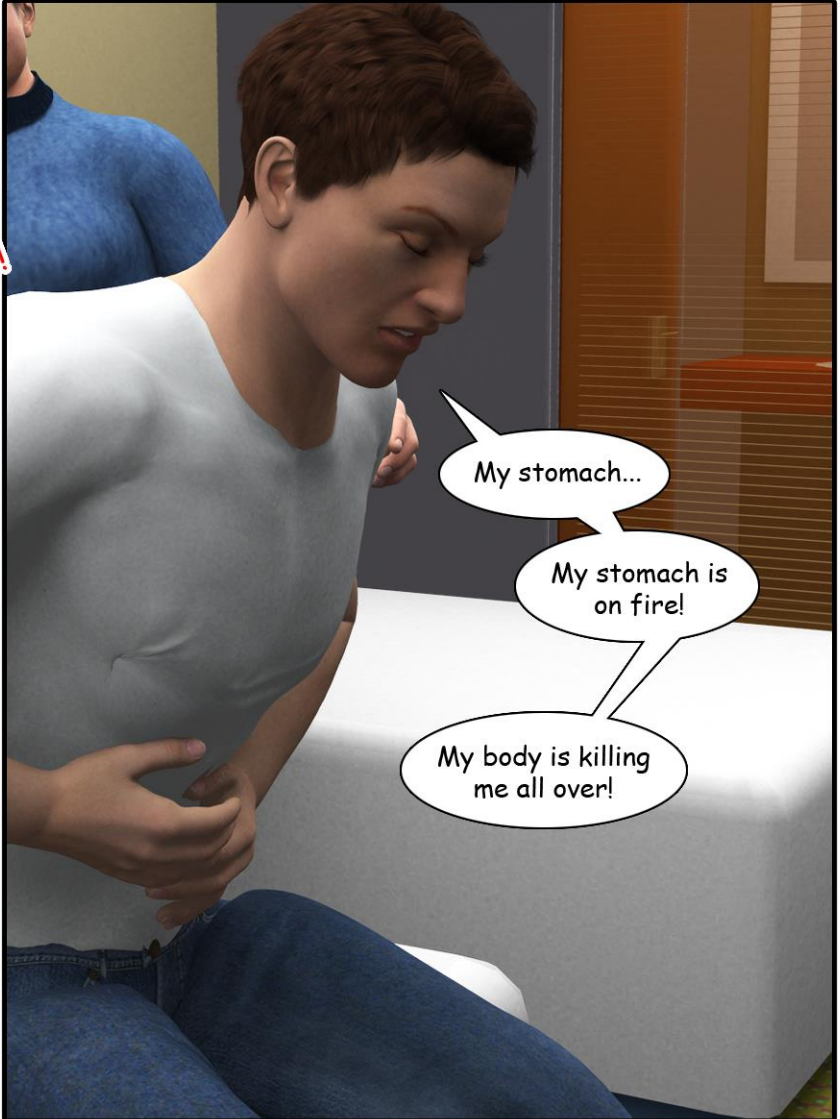


He plays every

Why don't you spit it out then?



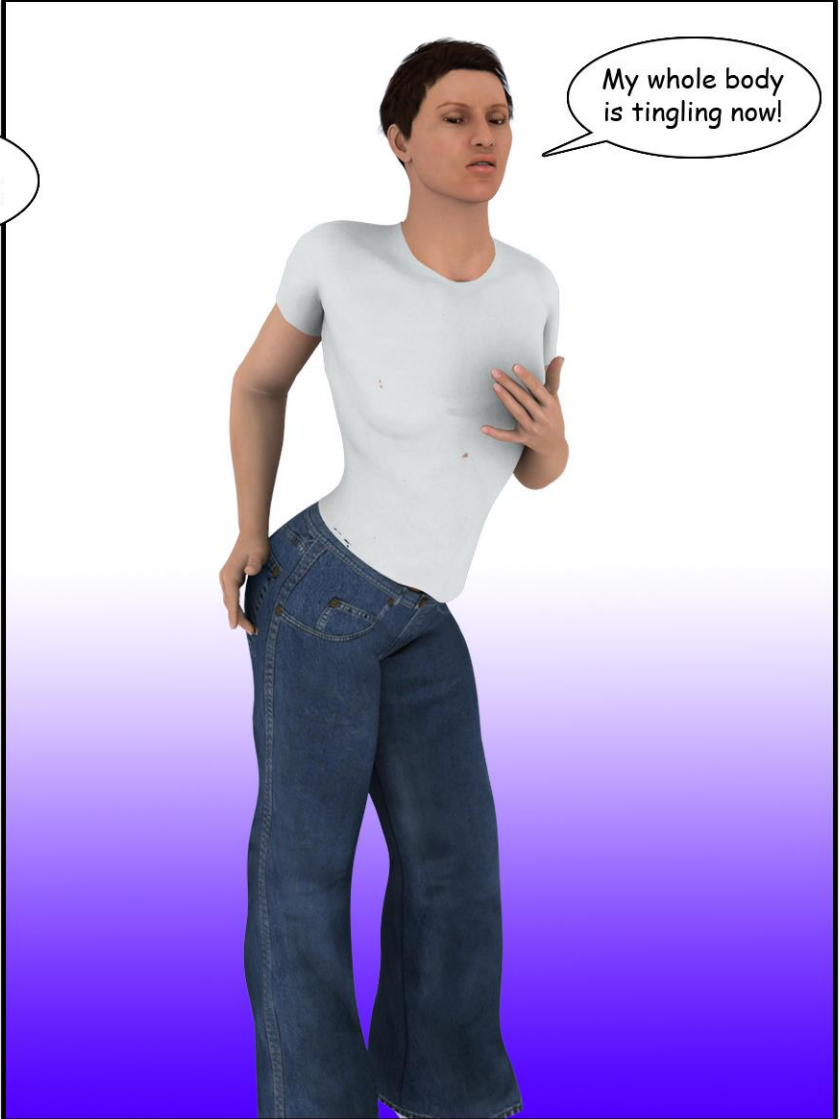
I, uh, already swallowed it.
